The Vernier was out at the end of the first scoring end for our Best Gold trophy, where Recurve Archer Chris Bottle shot to within 7mm of the spider at 80 yards but Carolyn Warren shot a fraction closer on the National round to win.



There were some good battles throughout the field, Gents Recurve in particular saw a number of different Archers top the leader board as the competition progressed and the Junior lady recurve places swapped on the last dozen to be settled by just 4 points. Well done to Scott for making it 3 years as our Gents Compound champion.

Congratulations to Rob who claimed his six gold end at 80 yards and especially to Zeyd for his Junior Barebow UK Record claim.

The team competition also came right down to the wire between Malvern Archers represented by Beulah, Kathi and Hazel (Girl power!) just edging it over Bromyard Bowmen who had Carolyn, Luke and TJ providing their top scores. Droitwich were 3rd having been very well represented on the day, and with excellent scores from their Junior Novice archers.

Talking of Novices, congratulations to all of you, I hope this tournament was a positive step in your continuing enjoyment in the sport. We had Archers from three clubs claiming the titles. Gents Recurve had the most competitors with Andrew claiming victory for Evesham and there was quite literal a head to head match between Blythe and Emelia from Droitwich for the junior trophy. Well done also to Novice Lady Champion Claire representing Worcester Bowmen, and Chloe shooting Barebow and Steve Compound, both archers from Droitwich.

Thank you to Geoff Blissett for being our Gentleman Patron and to all from Malvern Archers who helped put this shoot on, it's quite a logistical challenge, but Team Relf did us proud as always and special mention for Ali Townsend and for Dave Martel for letting me get out of the scoring tent for the first time in 4 years.
